Source, who is not in a position to testify, advised as follows:

Source learned that an unidentified prostitute was murdered in the Henderson area in recent years. Allegedly, this individual had a needle in her arm at the time of her death. The murder was somehow covered up as it did not appear in the newspaper. Source will attempt to obtain more information regarding this apparent crime.

[redacted] (Henderson, Kentucky) is also a frequent customer at the Uncle Sam's strip club (previously described by source).

[redacted] Henderson Police Department [redacted] who has a very bad reputation. At the time of the Heather Teague kidnaping, [redacted] was involved in the [redacted] drug ring (previously described by source). Source strongly doubts that Marty Dill, a Teague case suspect, committed suicide since [redacted] was with him at the time of his death. [redacted] has been very "low key" ever since the kidnaping.

[redacted] was allegedly a part of some type of organized crime group approximately 5 - 6 years ago. [redacted] apparently did not pay on a debt and someone had him physically beaten for this reason. [redacted] was hospitalized for several weeks as a result of a bad eye injury and wore an eye patch for many months afterward.

Source has heard that certain public officials in Henderson strongly enforce methamphetamine violations in an effort to promote and protect their own cocaine business.
